

RVCU hubs / Visconn Clinic licences and support



41 Remote Visconn Clinic Units (RVCU) are being deployed across Lancashire and South Cumbria for practices and Primary Care Networks (PCN) to use in a variety of ways.

The [RVCU units](#) come with a 65 inch screen, an interactive display, 4K video and audio capabilities, are moveable, and are connected to 4G internet. They use [Visconn Clinic software](#), which is a purpose built video platform for clinicians.

RVCU units can be used in GP practices, care homes, community spaces, clinical supervision, training, education, MDT meetings, group consultations, board meetings, and [so much more](#).

Visconn Clinic licences can be used separately to the RVCU project, but have been purchased as part of that programme to support its use. For example, you could also use Visconn Clinic with direct patient consultations, virtual ward rounds, and in-house meetings. The software has been used across Lancashire and South Cumbria by front line staff and has [great use case studies](#).
